Call to Writers and Artists

County Lines Literary Journal is an annual literary anthology compiled by the Franklin County Arts Council Writers' Guild. The Writers' Guild is calling for entries of prose, poetry and art for the eighth edition to be published for 2021. There are no restrictions on age or residence of persons submitting. Past writers and artists have been from all over North Carolina and the Southeastern states.

The contest is open for previously unpublished works (this includes online publication):

- Poetry — no more than 30 lines per poem, single spaced (maximum five poems per contest entry)
- Prose — short story, essay, or creative non-fiction of 1,500 words or less (one per contest entry, maximum three entries)
- Art — submit as jpeg attachment high resolution - Paintings, Drawings, and Photographs (maximum 5 entries per artist). Cover Art should reflect title, *County Lines*. Art chosen for cover will be awarded \$25

Work cannot contain erotica, violence, hate, political editorial, or excessive profanity.

Type your name, address, phone number, word count (line count for poems), and email address in the upper left-hand corner of the cover page of your manuscripts, and your name and title of submission in the header of each manuscript page.
