- 2'x2' \$200.00 + Tax = \$213.50
- 3'x3' \$300.00 + Tax = \$320.25
- 4'x4' \$400.00 + Tax = \$427.00
- 6'x6' \$600.00 + Tax = \$640.50
- 8'x8' \$800.00 + Tax = \$854.00

Premium Quilt Block (More than 40 pieces/sections)

- 2'x2' \$300.00 + Tax = \$320.25
- 3'x3' \$400.00 + Tax = \$427.00
- 4'x4' \$500.00 + Tax = \$533.75
- 6'x6' \$700.00 + Tax = \$747.25
- 8'x8' \$900.00 + Tax = \$960.75
- Custom designed Block \$100.00 extra

Custom Design - Something specific to you, your family or your business? Our experienced designer can create the perfect custom designed block just for you! Designer retains copyright of all custom designs, but you get unlimited use of the design.

In making your request for a Quilt Trail application, you agree to accept the following conditions and requirements:

- I/We will work with the Quilt Trails of the Tar and Roanoke Rivers regarding design and colors of the proposed quilt square.
- The block cannot be my company logo nor can it be used as my company logo. There must be 1' of blank space around the smaller blocks and at least 2' of blank space around the 4', 6' and 8' blocks.
- The site must be accessible by a bucket truck for installation and one not encumbered by power lines.
- If the buyer chooses to be responsible for the installation, Quilt Trails of the Tar and Roanoke Rivers will provide an instruction kit, including supplies, illustrations, and consultation.
- The Quilt Block must remain on the building for a minimum of 5 years. Your Block will be on a map and part of the Quilt Trail Tour.
- Removal of the Block is a cost incurred by the Quilt Block owner.
- Once the final design of my Quilt Block is agreed and signed off on, no changes may be made to the block and I will not move or alter the quilt block in any way without first contacting the Quilt Trails of the Tar and Roanoke Rivers. I understand that if I move to a new location, the Quilt Block remains with the site where it is originally installed. A new location requires a new block. I cannot take the Quilt Block with me UNLESS it is painted to match a family quilt or is a custom design. In such case, the Requestor will need to make arrangements for removal and transport.
- I will allow my Quilt Block to be photographed by the public; and photos may be used by the Franklin County Arts Council and the Quilt Trails of the Tar River and Roanoke Rivers in advertising and for promotional materials.
- I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Franklin County Arts Council, the Martin County Arts Council, and Quilt Trails of the Tar and Roanoke Rivers committee as well as their officers, committees, agents, employees and volunteers for and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses and causes of action related to the Quilt Block installation.
- Blocks may be mounted on 4'X4' posts near a road if there is no suitable building on the property visible from the road. There will be an additional charge of \$100 for materials and labor for this option.
